IMPERSONATION SCAMS

With President Elliott joining our BHSU family, I would like to share a friendly reminder about the types of scams we receive from malicious entities impersonating university leadership over email.

Common impersonation scams we have seen recently include the following in the subject line: "Are you available?," "Kindly send me your cell phone number," "Available?," "Random Name has shared AReallyImportantSoundingFile.docx with you" (this type usually has the name of an administrative staff/faculty member within the body), and many others. Many of these are identifiable as the subject lines are prepended with the [EXT], or are tagged in Outlook as External. They are also identifiable when the sending email address is a non-BHSU email address, e.g. outlook.com, gmail.com, hotmail.com, or another entity outside of BHSU.

The goals of the scammers have been to convince victims into purchasing gift cards, scratching off the back, and sending pictures of the gift card codes to the scammer. Other goals are to gain access to a victim's email account through credential harvesting attacks to download emails, contact lists, SharePoint data, university data, personal data, and to gain access to university systems.

As always, if you receive any suspicious looking emails that could be phishing attempts, use the Phish Alert or Report button within your Outlook client or within Outlook online.

CSA and NFE Overtime Eligible Employees: (HOURLY)

- There are 176 hours in the November 22 December 21 pay period.
- Enter 8 holiday hours on Thursday, November 23 in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.
 - An employee who is required to work on the date a holiday is observed will receive 8 hours of holiday pay and hours worked.
 - o Eligible part-time employees will receive prorated holiday pay.
- Enter 8 Administrative Leave hours on Friday, November 24 in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.
 - Employees not scheduled to work on this day do not get the administrative holiday.
- If approved annual, sick, or comp time are used in any combination with hours worked, and totals more than 40 hours during the work week, the leave MUST be reduced to bring the total hours paid to 40 hours for the week.

- The Holiday Hours will populate during payroll processing, you do not need to add to your timesheet.

Faculty:

- Please send leave requests through the Leave Request System
 - Exempt must take leave in 8-hour increments.
- The Holiday Hours will populate during payroll processing, you do not need to add to your timesheet.

Supervisors:

- Please ensure your employees are requesting the <u>appropriate</u> time off and that the leave requests are approved <u>prior</u> to approving their timesheet.
