### 1095-C AND 1099 SA

### 1095-C

Per IRS regulations, 1095-C forms are required be provided to employees by March 2, 2023 for the tax year of 2022. You will receive the 1095-C form via mail from the South Dakota State Employee Benefits Program by March 2, 2023. Active employees with an email address on record will receive an electronic 1095-C in late February. The 1095-C form is a requirement of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). All employees who were eligible for coverage under the State of South Dakota's health plan, including those eligible for coverage under the ACA will receive a 1095-C, even if the employee chose to opt-out of the health plan. Additionally, any employee or dependent who enrolled in a health plan through COBRA continuation coverage in the calendar year that is being reported must be sent a 1095-C. An important thing to note though is that the 1095-Cs are no longer required to file taxes.

## 1099-SA

Employees who have contributed to or taken a distribution from a Health Savings Account (HSA) will need to report that on their Federal Income Tax. The forms are available to employees on the WEX portal (<a href="www.wexinc.com">www.wexinc.com</a>), and the forms are a 1099 SA for distributions, which is now available, and the 5487 SA for contributions, which will be mid-February. Additionally, if employees have questions about these documents, please direct them to call WEX at 866.451.3399.

### GEEK SPEAK: SEEKING THE UNSEEN: WHY AN ARTIST WENT A MILE UNDERGROUND

Seeking the Unseen: Why an Artist Went a Mile Underground

Gina Gibson is a Professor of Graphic Design at Black Hills State University (BHSU) in Spearfish, South Dakota. Gibson, an internationally exhibiting artist and lecturer, became the first-ever Artist-in-Residence (AiR) for the Sanford Underground Research Facility (SURF) in Lead, South Dakota. The deepest underground research laboratory in the United States, SURF

reaches a depth of nearly one mile below the surface and houses experiments in dark matter and neutrino physics, biology, geology and engineering. The success of the inaugural AiR program led to a new partnership between BHSU and SURF and the appointment of Gibson as the Coordinator of the program. Gibson will talk about how SURF's unique location, history and science have influenced her artwork.

## MySDRS & Linking Your MySDRS Account to mySD

MySDRS has been integrated with the mySD Citizen Portal. This affects how individuals log in to MySDRS to access their SDRS account. If you have not already created a mySD account, you will need to create one in order to link and access your MySDRS account. <u>IMPORTANT NOTE</u>: The mySD Citizen Portal is maintained by the Bureau of Information and Telecommunications (BIT) and not SDRS. Therefore, if you are having issues creating a mySD account or with the mySD log-in process, you should visit BIT's Help page

#### Member Account Information & Forms

Once logged in and linked, the MySDRS dropdown houses your personal SDRS account information, such as address/phone number/email, beneficiary designations, contribution and service details, and Final Average Compensation (FAC). Documents, such as statements and 1099s (if applicable), can now be downloaded through MySDRS for your convenience. Member forms can also be accessed once you are logged in to your MySDRS account. Our two most used forms (E-2: Personal Information Change Request and E-5: Beneficiary Designation) are now Self Service Forms that can be completed and submitted to SDRS electronically for a more streamlined process. You may still print forms off to complete and send to SDRS. Or you may contact the SDRS office to request forms. You may also use the Benefit Calculator (located under the "Calculators" tab) to estimate your SDRS retirement benefits using your personal information when you are logged in to MySDRS.

#### **Events**

All SDRS scheduled events are located on one central calendar (direct link to "Events" can be accessed under the "Menu" tab). The central calendar can be filtered by Category (individual counseling sessions, workshops, forums), Date, Location, or Type (in-person or virtual) to narrow events down to your specific area of interest or location. You may register for workshops and forums directly through the SDRS website. In the near future you will be able to book individual counseling sessions online; however, for now you must contact the SDRS office toll-free at 1-888-605-SDRS (7377) or <a href="mailto:sdrsweblink@state.sd.us">sdrsweblink@state.sd.us</a> to schedule an individual counseling session.
