FACULTY WORKSHOP: GETTING STARTED WITH FLIPPED TEACHING

Description: In a classic college course, students are assigned reading before a class session. The instructor then covers the assigned content through lecture (perhaps with discussion or through a demonstration) in a subsequent class. Students then take the knowledge they've built and apply it or transform it by completing an assignment or preparing for an upcoming test. In this traditional college classroom, students do the most challenging cognitive labor on their own after they receive a (hopefully compelling) presentation from the instructor on the relevant content.

Flipped learning re-orders that pattern, putting more passive learning activities (like listening to or watching lectures) outside of class and putting the most active, cognitively challenging activities (like applying concepts, solving problems, answering open questions) within the class session. A growing trend in higher education, particularly as students and instructors gain familiarity with asynchronous classes, flipped teaching is well supported by educational research. Join this workshop to hear from BHSU faculty who use flipped structures to teach their courses, explore some of the research that justifies flipped teaching, and generate some ideas for getting started down the road to flipping a class.

When does the E-Update run?

It runs once a week, every Tuesday (unless otherwise specified by the Marketing Office due to office closures or other circumstances of that nature).

How long do announcements run? Are they archived anywhere?

If you submit your announcement after 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday (intending for it to go out that same day) and you have not contacted us or made prior arrangements with us, there is no guarantee that your announcement will show up in that edition.

Do you allow images to be displayed in the body of the announcement?

No, but we can create a link to any image or attachment that you may want to be included in your announcement. If you have an image or attachment that you would like to be included in your announcement, please

email <u>Campus.eUpdate@BHSU.edu</u> with the attachment and make sure to specify which announcement you would like it to be added to.

What date am I supposed to put in the calendar widget on the E-Update submission form? Is it the date of my event?

No. The date you select on the calendar widget in the form tells us what edition this announcement needs to be included in.
