NEW PASSWORD RESET FEATURE

Network Computer Services (NCS) is enabling a new feature in Microsoft 365 called Self Service Password Reset (SSPR). If you forget your password, the current process requires you to navigate to our password reset portal and follow a reset procedure. With the new SSPR feature, you can click forgot my password directly from the Microsoft login page and reset your password by either entering a code from a phone call or text message, receiving a reset email to your alternate email address, or answering security questions.

In order to enable this feature, all users must have additional contact methods setup within Microsoft 365. NCS has prepopulated faculty, staff, and student alternate email addresses, however you are able to modify your alternate email or setup additional methods like texts and calls by going to https://aka.ms/ssprsetup and signing in with your BHSU credentials. Some faculty and staff were missing alternative email addresses in our system, if your account was missing that field, you will be required to add an additional contact method the next time you log into your Microsoft account. In the future, any new faculty, staff, or students will be required to setup their own additional contact information on their first log in to Microsoft 365 services.
