SUSTAINABILITY PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT: 8 WAYS HIKERS CAN PRACTICE SUSTAINABILITY WHILE ON THE TRAIL

1. **Explore local hiking trails**- voiding transport that emits a lot of CO2.
2. **Stick to the trails**- off trail can lead to animals losing their habitat, or you might have an unwanted encounter with them.
3. **Refrain using open fire**- creating an open campfire in an undesignated area can be dangerous.
4. **Dispose of trash properly**-waste management is a massive part of being a sustainable hiker.
5. **Invest in well-made hiking gear**-with high-quality hiking gear, you reduce the times that you need a replacement.
6. **Be respectful of the wildlife**- being respectful to wildlife means that you should avoid getting close to and interacting with thm as much as possible.

7. **Set up camp in established campsites**-you should avoid setting up camps outside of established campsites.
8. **Lead by example**-whether you are hiking solo or with friends, you must be a responsible hiker and conscious of your actions. Doing so allows you to set a great example and encourage others to be more sustainable when hiking.
