PAM CARRIVEAU TO SERVE AS ACTING PROVOST

In early June Provost Priscilla Romkema informed me that she planned to leave her position at Black Hills State University effective July 21. Given the short timeframe, it was apparent that an interim Provost would be necessary for the 2021-2022 academic year. In the past month I have been in conversation with senior leaders in academics including the Assistant Provost and Deans. We have identified a range of options for an interim Provost and are exploring those now. I will have more information for you about an Interim Provost as we get closer to the start of fall semester.

In the near term, I have asked Ass't Provost Pam Carriveau to serve as Acting Provost for the next few weeks until a decision is made on an Interim Provost. Pam has agreed and will assume Acting Provost duties on July 22. I thank her for stepping up and agreeing to assume these additional responsibilities.

I know that I join many of you in wishing Dr. Romkema the very best in her future. She has provided more than 20 years of service to BHSU and while her time as Provost was short, she certainly has given many years prior as a faculty member, Chair and Dean. She leaves a legacy that will be remembered long into the future.
