IMPORTANT CAMPUS NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES SURROUNDING TITLE IX

BHSU's Title IX office will be undergoing several changes, primarily due to the SD BOR moving to a shared service model for all Title IX investigations. Beginning August 22, Title IX duties will change as follows:

- 1. All reporting of sexual violence or harassment should be directed to Breon Derby. Dr. Derby will handle in-take of sexual violence/harassment reports, collect basic information to hand off to an investigator, and provide support measures. Dr. Derby can be located at Young Center 206, via e-mail at Breon.Derby@bhsu.edu or 605-641-0668.
- 2. Investigations will be handled centrally by specially trained staff located either at the BOR office or an assigned BOR campus.

- 3. Mike Isaacson, former Title IX Coordinator will be transferring to Ellsworth Airforce Base to work in the nearly opened BHSU office and serve as an enrollment specialist.
- 4. Jane Klug, Dean of Students and her staff will assume responsibility for campus education and sexual assault prevention programming.
